The Nebraska Wind Symphony was founded in 1977 by Tony Snyder, our guest conductor today. Since then, more than 400 amateur musicians from all walks of life have participated in its concerts. The current playing roster numbers approximately 85. The Wind Symphony was established as a non-profit corporation of the State of Nebraska in 1979.

Our next scheduled performance for this season is Sunday, **February 18, 2007**, here at the UNO Strauss Performing Arts Center, at 3:00 as usual.

On Sunday afternoon **April 15, 2007**, we continue the celebration with former NWS director SMSgt. Larry MacTaggart. MacTaggart will conduct his new composition, commissioned to celebrate this season. MacTaggart will be donating his commission fee as seed money for a scholarship planned as a memorial to the many Wind Symphony members who have passed on. Our goal is to match Larry's donation with grants and individual donations, so that our scholarship eventually will provide assistance for college students who are participating in music performance. We have all benefited from our experience and hope to pass along our enthusiasm and support.
